2) Under the DASHBOARD menu, go to [redacted] and view your [redacted]

Under the same [redacted] submenu check out your results for [redacted] and sort by HTTP status, then use the drop down toggle to show the page(s) reporting the link.

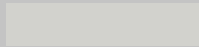

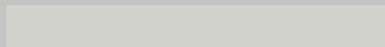
