Academic-Related positions support the academic mission of the University. Academic Assistant, Graduate Teaching Assistant, Teaching Fellow, and Postdoctoral Fellow job postings are advertised on the respective Departmental websites.

An academic assistant is a part-time, non-student employee who generally assists a member of the academic staff and who supports academic activities related to a degree credit course or program. Academic assistants, including Tutors and Markers, perform duties such as preparation for tutorials and/or lab demonstrations, preparation of written and audio-visual materials, instruction, leading discussions, supervising laboratories, grading exams and assignments, consulting with students, setting up experiments, conducting field trips and assisting with curriculum and course material development.

Graduate Teaching Assistants and Teaching Fellows are registered graduate students who are employed to act as teaching assistants or teaching fellows for degree credit courses.
