when the signs go missing, there is st II something there. He added that he would like to invest gate tact le paint that has a raised surface, which may be a subst tute.

First Aid Kits – A Laranjeira

S Smith stated that S Hawryszko has received updated informat on from EH&S for what is required in f rst aid kits, where to get the seals, and is currently sourcing suppliers.

A Laranjeira added that per the regulat ons from WSIB, the First Aid stat on shall be maintained and in the charge of a worker who works in the immediate vicinity of the stat on and is a qualif ed f rst aider. She added that we could go through the list (of f rst aiders) and assign people to be in charge of the f rst aid kit(s). The regulat ons also state:

The box shall be large enough so that each item is in plain view and easily accessible.

A checklist to make sure that everything is there as well as inspect ons that are no less than quarterly, with each box marked with the date and the signature of the person inspect ng it. S Smith responded that currently, assigning S Hawryszko, (Assistant Manager), to that role is his preferred route because it's consistency across all 18 buildings and there is more value for us to have a single point person to do it.

Agenda/Minute proposal - A Laranjeira

A Laranjeira suggested that within the minutes, instead of bullet points, an item is dated for tracking purposes, to ident fy how long it has been on the agenda.

Inspect ons – S Smith and A Laranjeira

No inspect ons have been completed to date. S Smith stated that by the next meet ng, we should endeavour to have several buildings completed.

Incident/Accident Reports - A Laranjeira

An employee reported that the weight in a garbage bag shif ed while put ng it in the dumpster, causing her hand and arm to turn awkwardly. Three f ngers were bent, and a nail was torn, medical at ent on was sought, and they returned to modif ed dut es, no t me was lost from work. A worker reported that while she was cleaning a bathroom, she bent forward and struck her head with force on the bathroom door. Her vision was blurred momentarily, she experienced headache and swelling and was diagnosed with a concussion. Time was lost from work.

<u>Mental Injury</u> – A Laranjeira

A Laranjeira stated that we of en forget that injury just isn't physical but is somet mes mental, this year when staf were switching over to conference season, things could have gone bet er, and we could have been more proact ve. She added:

Previously we had meet ngs where everyone was given the same informat on, that did not happen this year and there was frustrat on between co-workers trying to be on the same page and meet deadlines.

I am wondering if it is possible to have the pre-conference season meet ng moving forward. S Smith will bring this item forward to R Byrom and S Hawryszko.
