WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE

Students on unpaiplacements who are whoing in a setting where employees are covered by workers' compensation through the Workplace Safety and InsurancerdB(0WSIB) would also be eligible for the coverage in the event of a work-related injury.

The WSIB policy states:

"individuals who are placed by training eargcies with employers too btain work skills and experience, but who are not paid by the employer, are "learners". Teh "employer" of these individuals is the employer with whom they are placed

Under this policy, trainingparticipants are "learners" if:

- the placement is authorized by the training agency,
- the individual participates, however minimally, in the activities of the placement employer's industry inobing job shadowing,
- they are not paid by the employer.

For students who are placed with employers who do not have WSIB ceverage conpleting their upaid placement otside of Ontario, refer to the & + 8 % % INSURANCE section.
