Temporary Suspension of AdmissionChecklist

The following process should followed prior to submitting a notice to the Senate of a temporary suspension of admissions. Note that, per the P, they recommended procedures apply to any program designation that appears on a student's transocript, the exception of graduate fields that appear on graduate student transcripts.

The Senate recognizes that the decision to tempor**arily**pend admission can be made by the relevant Dean(s) in consultation with their Faculty Board or equivalent.

Prior to submitting a notice of temporary suspension to the Senatbe following checklist should be consulted and confirmation that the checklist was consulted be referenced in the documentation provided.
