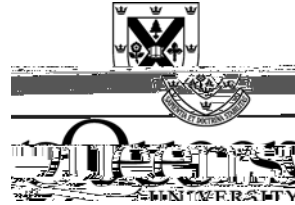

of Mining became the "Queen's University Faculty of Applied Science", with Dr. Goodwin as Dean. At present the Faculty of Applied Science has approximately twenty six hundred undergraduate students and five hundred graduates within 10 programs; 6 engineering and 4 engineering science offering a number of options.

Changing the name of the Faculty to include the word engineering while maintaining the words applied science, recognizes the diversity of the programming at both the undergraduate and graduate level.

**Motion to Faculty Board to name the Faculty of Applied Science at Queen's University**

At the November 18, 2009 meeting of the Applied Science Faculty Board I will move:

*“That the name of the Faculty of Applied Science at Queen's University be changed to include the word Engineering” (Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science OR Faculty of Applied Science and Engineering)*

Note: once approved at Faculty Board, the motion will then be carried forward to Senate, via SCAD.
