### **Implications**

These recommendations clarify current practice and provide direction to list awards that require academic excellence or are related to exceptional performance in an academic program of study on the official transcript. Further, financial need based awards and athletic awards will not appear on the official transcript.

### **Implementation**

May 2011 – to correspond with the transition to a new administrative system.

Academic Excellence is currently defined as:

First Entry Admission Scholarships: equal to or greater than 90%.

In course Scholarships: equal to or greater than 80%.

Graduate Fellowships: equal to or greater than 80%.

### **Summary**

The Senate Committee on Scholarships and Student Aid, Policy Sub Committee, recommended the Policy on Scholarships and Awards Appearing on Transcripts be forwarded to the Senate Committee on Academic Procedures (SCAP) for consideration.
