Prepare answers to each of the following three questions, and attach to the signature page for submission as one pdf document. Precede each answer with the question as provided. Limit one page total with 12-point Times New Roman font (or equivalent) and 1" margins.

1. **Elevator pitch:** Imagine you have 1 minute to tell someone about your research plans, and to convince them it is important and meaningful research. Tell us what you would say.
2. **Personal Impact:** Describe how this opportunity in social sciences, humanities and/or creative arts research will contribute to your academic experience.
3. **Broader Impact:** Describe the potential relevance of the research to (a) the field of study, and (b) a broader audience beyond your field of study (in/outside academia). E.g. What new knowledge will your research contribute, and who will benefit?

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#### Submissions MUST follow the formatting instructions to be considered eligible:

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Combine your portion of the USSRF application into **ONE PDF** document containing all components in the following order: completed signature page, one-page question attachment, and unofficial transcript.

Submit your application using the following format:
